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**Tardy Policy:**

Mornings (Advisory on M/F, A Block on T/W, C Block on Th):

- Students in the building at 7:45 am, but late to class will be sent to the office for a tardy slip. This is their pass to class (every 3 unexcused tardies = 30 minute detention).
- Students arriving between 7:45 am and 8:00 am will receive a tardy pass from the main office. This is their pass to enter class (every 3 unexcused tardies = 30 minute detention).
- Students arriving after 8:00 am and not excused by a parent will receive a detention slip from the main office. This is their pass to class.

During the School Day:

- Students who enter the classroom after the bell will be issued a detention slip and marked tardy in Infinite Campus (1 unexcused tardy = 30 minute detention).
- Students who are 10 or more minutes late to class (without a pass) will receive a behavior referral in Infinite Campus for administrative intervention.
